

Strap double loop

For a breast collar, I make the tugs that attach the collar to the saddle just a bit differently. The tugs are a bit more work, but when in use, they function great. Essentially there's a loop on the bottom of the strap that keeps the whole thing attached to the breast collar side D-ring so you can buckle and unbuckle without the strap falling off into the dirt.

Since the layout is a bit more complicated than a standard sewn-in fixed loop, I made a page which explains how this is done. This same configuration would also be useful if you needed to buckle and unbuckle a strap that needs to remain on a piece of hardware while the billet end can be utilized. This page shows the set up prior to stitching. It's a hand stitching job and you'll need the appropriate sized loop irons and mini clamps for your stitching horse to effectively do this job.
