Saddle tree on Finished stand

Notice that tree sits level as viewed from side.
This is very important when trying to
establish lines of skirts and other pattern
elements on tree.



Each time tree is removed from stand and replaced, it must drop into a pocket for consistancy. The "pocket" needs to be self-centering so all trees will fit as though on a horse's back. Do not build a stand for a downhill horse. Pad up for this situation if necessary. Use #200 snaps without springs for hooks on under strap (can be nylon or leather).
